Minutes of the Llanwnnen Community Council held on Wednesday evening 4th March 2020 at 7.30pm at the Grannell Hotel, Llanwnnen.

1. CHAIRMAN'S WELCOME / CROESO'R CADEIRYDD

4. DECLARE PERSONAL INTERESTS / DATGELU BUDDIANNAU PERSONOL

Due to a letter received from Mudiad Meithrin Drefach Cllrs David Thomas, Aeron Hughes and Yvonne Davies stepped out of the room and due to a planning enquiry with regards to Pantyrhwch, Llanwnnen, Cllr Erika Davies stepped out of the room. / *Datgelwyd Buddiannau Personol gan y cynghorwyr David Thomas, Aeron Hughes ac Yvonne Davies yn dilyn llythyr dderbyniwyd oddi wrth Mudiad Meithrin Drefach ac yn ogystal gan y Cyng Erika Davies yn dilyn Cais Cynllunio yn Pantyrhwch, Llanwnnen.*

5. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING / COFNODION Y CYFARFOD DIWETHAF

The Vice-Chairman read the minutes for the last meeting and were found correct by Cllr Emyr Lloyd and seconded by Cllr Aeron Hughes.

Darllenwyd cofnodion y cyfarfod diwethaf gan yr Is-Gadeirydd. Cynigwyd eu bod yn gywir gan y Cyng. Emyr Lloyd ac eiliwyd gan y Cyng Aeron Hughes.

6. MATTERS ARISING / MATERION YN CODI

- **Planters:** Following on from the last meeting Cllr Erika Davies suggested that it would be better to plant Spring flowering bulbs around the Llanwnnen sign posts. This was agreed by the committee and it was passed that planters should be ordered and positioned on the bridge and on either side of the village. Cllr Aeron Hughes had obtained details from CCF with regards to the concrete water troughs that may be used as planters which are 4ft long and at a price of £52 each. It was passed that 6 planters should be ordered by Cllr Aeron Hughes. Cllr Erika Davies suggested that she would be able to

purchase 280 plug plant Begonia flowers for £54.37. This was also passed that she should order the flowers and compost. It was also suggested that during the VE day celebrations it should be announced to the parish of the forthcoming plans and if any individuals were interested in watering the plants.

Yn dilyn ymlaen o'r cyfarfod diwethaf awgrymodd y Cyng Erika Davies y byddai'n well plannu bylbiau blodau'r Gwanwyn o amgylch arwyddion y pentref. Cytunodd y cynghorwyr a paswyd y dylai'r potiau gael eu gosod ar y bont a phob pen o'r pentref. Roedd y Cyng Aeron Hughes wedi derbyn pris oddi wrth CCF am gafnau dŵr concriid i'w defnyddio fel potiau blodau - £52 yr un. Pasiwyd y dylid archebu 6. Dynododd y Cyng Erika Davies y byddai modd iddi hithau archebu 280 o flodau Begonia plwg am £54.37. Pasiwyd y dylai archebu blodau a chompost. Awgrymwyd yn ystod dathliadau VE y dylid datgan cynlluniau'r cyngor i drigolion y Plwyf gan ofyn a fyddai gan unrhyw un ddiddordeb mewn dyfrio'r blodau.

- Grass cutting – Cllr Aeron Hughes confirmed that Mike Brown was willing to cut the grass for a fee of £400. The grass cutting would be done between 5/6 times a year. / *Cadarnhaodd y Cyng Aeron Hughes y byddai Mike Brown yn cymryd at y gwaith o dorri porfa am £400 y flwyddyn. Bydd yn torri'r borfa rhwng 5/6 gwaith y flwyddyn.*
- Website – As suggested in the last meeting communication was made with Gwenan Jenkins, Clerk of Llanwenog Community Council with regards to the change in our website. She informed that she did not understand much about this as they have a digital advisor of their own who does the work. It was passed that we carry on with Elfed Jenkins' suggestions. / *Fel nodwyd yn y cyfarfod diwethaf, cysylltwyd â Gwenan Jenkins, Clerc Cyngor Cymuned Llanwenog ynglŷn â newid ein gwefan. Nid oedd ganddi hi lawer o wybodaeth am hyn am fod ganddynt hwy ymgynghorydd eu hunain. Pasiwyd y dylid dilyn awgyrmiadau Elfed Jenkins.*
- V E Day Celebrations – Will be held at the Grannell Hotel. It was suggested that the Community Council made a free Hogg Roast for the residents of the Parish. It was suggested that the Council should order 200 rolls and that Cllr Euros Davies would find out how much pork would be needed. The celebration would commence at 6pm. An advert should be placed in 'Clonc' informing residents of the evening and Cllr Emyr Lloyd would be in charge of creating posters. / *I'w gynnal yng Ngwesty'r Grannell. Awgrymwyd y dylai'r Cyngor rostio mochyn am ddim i drigolion y plwyf. Awgrymwyd y dylid archebu 200 o roliau bara ac y byddai y Cyng Euros Davies yn ffeindio faint o gig fyddai angen. Byddai'r*

dathliadau yn dechrau am 6yh. Dylid hysbysebu'r noson yn 'Clonc' a byddai y Cyng Emyr Lloyd yn creu posteri.

7. CORRESPONDENCE / GOHEBIAETH

- Letter from Ceredigion CC highways department with regard to the bend at Capel y Groes. It was noted in the letter that as no reports of personal injury collisions from the police had been received with regard to this bend and as they believed that the signage installed was adequate, that there was nothing more that they could do. They did inform that after assessing the road it was due for a surface treatment which would be completed in the next financial year.

- Letter of request from Cruse Bereavement Care.
- Letter of request from Mudiad Meithrin Drefach. Due to Personal Matters Cllrs David Thomas, Aeron Hughes and Yvonne Davies stepped out of the room. It was suggested by Cllr Emyr Lloyd and seconded by Cllr Erika Davies that a donation of £100 should be given. / *Llythyr oddi wrth Mudiad Meithrin Drefach. - One Voice Wales membership fee of £72 *Tâl aelodaeth.*
- Zurich Insurance renewal fee of £219.51. It was passed by the committee to pay this fee as it was very similar to last year's quote.
- Defibrillator maintenance- It was passed that Cllr Emyr Lloyd would be in charge of this device.
- Letter of request from Citizens Advice – It was proposed by Cllr Emyr Lloyd and seconded by Cllr David Thomas to give a £25 donation.
- Letter of request from HAHAV (a hospice in Ceredigion) – It was proposed by Cllr Aeron Hughes and seconded by Cllr Erika Davies to give a donation of £100.

9. PLANNING/CYNLLUNIO

Change of season for established tourism business at Pantyrhwch, Llanwnnen from March to the end of October to cover year usage. Cllr Erika Davies declared a personal matter and stepped out of the room. The Committee had no objections and gave their full support.

10. ANY OTHER BUSINESS / UNRHYW FATER ARALL

- Super Fast Broadband – Cllr Erika Davies informed the committee that she had rung BT with regards to the Broadband at Capel y Groes as it is at the end of the Cwrtnewydd line. BT had advised her to express an interest with Openreach and she had asked the neighbouring residents to do the same. She had also contacted AM Elin Jones and MP Ben Lake with regards to this and they had informed her that they will try and do all that they can.
- Mobile Library – Cllr Erika Davies informed the committee that a Mobile Library visits Llanwnnen at Bro Cadarn on the 2nd Friday of every month at 9.30. Committee suggested that this information should be displayed on the Llanwnnen notice board and at Alltfawr together with the Council’s webpage. All information is shown on Ceredigion CC Facebook page.
