10. ANY OTHER BUSINESS / UNRHYW FATER ARALL

- It was informed that Mr Paul Abson was standing down as the Community Council Rubbish Collector due to him having sold his house and moving to Spain. It was passed that a thank you letter be sent thanking him for his services and also sympathising with him with regards to the loss of his wife. As this leaves a vacancy it was passed that a poster advertising the job be situated on the notice board and Pentrebach garage./ *Cyhoeddwyd fod Mr Paul Abson yn camu lawr o'i swydd fel Casglwr Ysbwriel y Cyngor Cymuned am ei fod wedi gwerthi ei dŷ ac yn symud i Sbaen. Penderfynwyd y dylid anfon llythyr o ddiolch iddo yn ogystal ag yn cydymdeimlo ag ef ar gollu ei wraig yn ddiweddar. Oherwydd fod y swydd bellach yn wâg, pasiwyd y dylid gosod poster yn hysbysebu'r swydd ar fwrdd cyhoeddiadau y pentref yn ogystal ag yng ngarej Pentrebach.*

- Butterfly Garden – Following a letter from Keep Wales tidy a few months ago informing of a competition for Community Councils to win plants, seeds, compost, planters, trellies etc to be planted in their locality, Cllr Erika Davies had kindly completed the form on behalf of Llanwnnen Community Council. The council have now been informed of their success and that a Butterfly garden package had been awarded to the value of £500. Cllr Erika Davies informed the council that a location for the garden would need to be discussed. It was decided after a brief discussion that there were several sites which could be considered – Plan A - The grass verge on the square in Llanwnnen and the Verge towards Bro Grannell. Plan B – The embankment opposite The Grannell Hotel or the verge from the Grannell towards the bridge. Cllr Davies advised that due to the rules of the competition she would need to get in touch with Steve Williams from the Planning Dept at Ceredigion CC and also permission would have to be granted by the Highways Dept. All work needs to be completed by the end of March.
- Flower Planters – Positive comments had been received from residents and passers by as to the flowering planters over the summer. Cllr Erika Davies proposed that the same should be done for next summer and perhaps purchase a few more planters. It was also suggested that spring daffodil bulbs could also be purchased and planted. Cllr Erika Davies will look into the cost of the bulbs.
- Cllr Erika Davies had been contacted by Mr Kevin Williams with regard to the Llanwnnen Church's plans for the Church Hall. He will contact the Council again with further information in due course.
- It was raised as to the condition of the road between Hendryd and Fish and Anchor and the amount of water running on the road due to the gutters being blocked. It was passed that a letter be sent to Ceredigion Council Highways Dept. Informing them of this.
- Due to the present pandemic and lockdown it was raised by Cllr Euros Davies that we should consider holding our meeting in future via Zoom. This is something the committee should consider.
